At the assembly of Co-workers, volunteers, and residents held at the centre at Pamplemousses in Mauritius on 25-03-2011, the

French provincial officially announced that the Province has completed all the process in respect of Canon and Civil laws to transfer the Centre to the Indian Province. He read out the transfer order of Prior General Donatus Forkan.



At the Annual General Assembly of the Association held at Pamplemousses on 25 March 2011, French Provincial affirmed the decision of the Province and read out the Transfer letter of Prior General. The Association reorganized with appointment of a 2/3rds (two third majority) Association's membership from the membership of the Indian Province.



The formal celebration would take place at Pamplemousses in Mauritius on 11 February 2012.
