At the first meeting of the HFG, Mr. Jacob Kora and Mr. Antony Joseph were unanimously selected as Chairperson and Secretary respectively. Before the forthcoming General Chapter of the Order in 2012 the HFG would meet a couple of times and report back to the Provincial leadership and Chapter members.
